**Champion & Reserve to be sold Friday at 12noon. Other show entrants can be sold after, or in their balloted turn if the vendor wishes. Vendor to inform the Auctioneers at the conclusion of the show.**

**Pens of 4 will be shown on Friday Morning at 8.30am Prompt**

**Champion pen of 4 steers & heifers to be sold in their fours in their balloted order.**

**Prize money is dependent upon cattle being sold through the Auction Ring.**
